SYNOPSIS

Relief/Grievances:-

1. Prayer for directing the concerned respondents to consider the case of petitioner and appointing her about 2413 posts out of the 34540 posts of primary Teachers Trained arising out of Advertisement No 2010 of 2010 in the light of order dated 18th July 2013 in S.L.P. (civil) No 26824 of 2012 and further directing the staff selection commission to include the name of petitioner as

primary Teacher (Trained) by preparing the panel because she has been discharging her duty as the panchayat Teacher (Trained) because she has required qualification.

2. That the name of petitioner is not included in panel of Hon'ble Justice Chatopadhyaya and her serial No- 102836 is already allotted and same was approved by staff selection commission Bihar.

3. That the petitioner has not moved either before Hon'ble the Supreme Court or Hon'ble this Court earlier for the same grievance.

FACTS:-

That petitioner is trained Teacher with qualification of B.T. in Teaching from Government Institute

2.2.1967 date of birth of the petitioner.

1983- That she has passed Matriculation examination with first ^{division} in the year 1983 from High School, Tulsia.

1985- That petitioner has success fully passed Intermediate examination.

1994- That petitioner has ^{passed} success fully two years training Couse examination in 1994.

9.1.07- Petitioner has been selection and thereafter she has been appointed on 9.01.2007 as the post of panchayat Teacher/Prakhand Teacher. That accordingly petitioner has joined on 9.01.2007 in the block.

13.1.07- She has joint in upgraded middle School, Tinkonma under Murliganj block in district Madhepura.

That thereafter petitioner has applied for the appointment/selection of assistant Teacher in ensuing

process initiated by the respondents against vacancies of 34540 Teachers under Bihar Vishesh Prathmik Shikshak Niyukti Niyamavali Rule. Thereafter proper verification, application was accepted but petitioner was not selected.

That name of petitioner was included in seniority list at sl. No. 102836 which is already made by staff selection commission, Bihar.

13.10.11- That order dated 13.10.11 on the contempt petition filed in S.L.P. (C) No 22882 of 04 arising out of the breach of undertaking given on 18.01.2006 by the state of Bihar and the order passed on the basis thereof on 23.01.06 in the aforesaid S.L.P. and your lordships were pleased to direct the trained


teachers who at one time were less than the number of vacant posts should be given appointment in the vacancies that were available.

18.07.13- that order dated 18.07.13 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court whereby it is directed that some discrepancies had crept in the final select list, the individual grievances contained various anomalies which, it is difficult for us to unravel. That order dated

13.10.11 was modified by your lordships allow the ^{concerned}~~affected~~ applicants to approach the Hon'ble High Court for redressed of their grievances. It is also directed that the applications special leave petitions and writ petitions filed before Hon'ble Apex Court has been disposed of with

liberty to the parties to approach the Hon'ble High Court individually or otherwise, for relief, if any but without in any way affecting the appointments of those teachers who have already been appointed against the vacant 34540 posts and are working. It is also directed that about 2413 posts out of the 34540 posts were still left to be filled up.

Hence this writ petition.

Most Respectfully Sheweth:-

1. That by the present writ petition, the
petitioner craves indulgence of this
Hon'ble Court for the following
reliefs:-

- (1) For directing the concerned
respondents to consider the case of
petitioner and appointing her about
2413 posts out of the 34540 posts of
primary Teachers (Trained) in the

light of order dated 18th July, 2013 in Special leave petition (civil) No. 26824 of 2012 and further directing the Staff Selection Commission to include the name of petitioner as primary Teacher (Trained) by preparing the panel. ~~the~~

(ii) For any other relief or reliefs for which the petitioner may be found entitle the facts and circumstances of the present case

2. That this writ petition is sought to be filed and maintained on the following amongst others main grounds:-

(i) Whether the respondent-authorities ought to have appreciated the fact that the institution of petitioner is

Government recognized institution imparting the degrees of training course for the purpose of appointment as the Assistant teacher.

(ii) Whether the action of the respondent authorities is malafide, ill-considered and in violation of several directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court with respect to the trained candidates of the different recognized institution.

(iii) Whether the authority concerned had failed to appreciate that petitioner was to be appointed in terms of the different orders ~~passed by Hon'ble~~ *different proceeding including contempt petition (C) No -* apex court under the ¹297 of 2007 and as such any interference by the

authority will amount to be the violation of judicial verdict?

(iv) Whether the authorities have appreciated that seniority merit list was prepared and submitted by the department before the Hon'ble apex court by compliance of the judicial verdict and its course the said seniority list was upheld by the Hon'ble apex court and the directions were issued with respect to appointment from the same list and to complied the judicial verdict passed under the different proceeding including the contempt proceeding?


(v) Whether the authorities have failed to appreciate that the similarly situated

persons who have appointed as the assistant Teacher in compliance of the judicial verdicts on open of contempt proceeding then the authority cannot/should not interfered in the output of the said compliance keeping in mind that the interference, if any under the finality which has already taken effect shall be the gross contempt in the order of the Hon'ble apex court.

(vi) Whether the action of the respondents are malafide arbitrary, without jurisdiction as well as abuse of power vested in them.

(vii) Whether the action of the respondents are otherwise bad in law and from the



facts as stated above, it requires interference and appoint in service to the petitioner.

3. That the petitioner is citizen of India and she is residing within the territorial jurisdiction of this Hon'ble court. Petitioner is come under reserved category and she is come under other backward class category. Therefore petitioner has required qualification for selecting the post of Trained Teacher.

4. That it is stated that the state Government has decided to fill up the post of the Assistant Teacher numerically 34540 in compliance of the judicial verdict, the rule was enacted and applications were call up having the



qualification of Teachers Training under Advertisement No 210 of 2010.

5. That it is stated that the petitioner and others having requisite qualification had filled up the application along with the testimonials as well as others required papers before the competent authority. It is also submitted that after proper verification session wise integrated seniority list was prepared in respect of the Advertisement No. 210 of 2010. It is further submitted that in pursuant to the directions issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court under contempt petition (C) No- 297 of 2007 the dispute with respect to seniority correctness or any facts were placed and duly considered by the special

officer appointed for the said purpose.

It is further submitted that on or after the settlement the panel was prepared by the respondent authority in which name of petitioner are not placed in serial number before Hon'ble court.

6. That it is stated that authority concerned after completing the process under the law has verified the relevant papers including testimonial and they were assured to be appointed because petitioner has requisite qualification for selecting on the said post of Trained Teacher.

7. That petitioner is trained from Government institute i.e. P.T.E. college, Madhepura in the year 1994 and she has

secured first division with good marks. She also passed matriculation examination in 1983 from High School Tulsia and she has secured first division. That certificate of training and Matriculation examination ~~are~~ ^{already been issued by Bihar} School Examination committee, in which date of birth has already been recorded as on 2.02.1967. That the petitioner has successfully passed Intermediate examination 1985 and she also passed Bachelor of Art (Honours) examination with second division. Thereafter she has passed Master of Art examination also.

8. That petitioner has been selected and thereafter she has been appointed on 09.01.2007 as the post of panchayat/prakhand Teacher that accordingly petitioner has joined on 09.01.2007 in the block and thereafter she has joined on 13.01.2007 in upgraded middle School, Tinkonma, under Murliganj block in district Madhepura.

9. That it may be mentioned that petitioner has applied for the appointment/selection of Assistant Teacher in ensuing process initiated by the respondents. i.e. state of Bihar, Department of Human Resources

Development against vacancies of 34540 Teachers under "Bihar Vishesh Prathamik Shikshak Niyukti Niyamavali Rules" thereafter proper verification, application was accepted but petitioner was not selected.

10. That it is relevant to mention here that seniority list prepared by the respondents has been properly examined and names of petitioners ~~were~~ also included in the same list but ~~she~~ ~~were~~ not considered without assigning any comment, reason best known by themselves.

A Photostat ~~copy~~ of part of the seniority list showing name of the petitioner is annexed here with marked as Annexure-2

and these form parts of
this petition.

11. That it is also stated that the petitioner and others candidates having same qualification of training from Government institute were included in the seniority list and some of the persons have been selected and petitioner ~~is~~ was deprived from the selection process without any ry ~~me~~ or reason. Thereafter petitioner ~~is~~ has ~~se~~ raised ~~the~~ ~~objections~~ before staff selection commission but she ~~but~~ ~~petitioner~~ was not considered as yet.

12. That it is also relevant to mention here that government has decided to fill up the post of Assistant Teacher numerically 34540 in compliance of judicial verdict as stated above in said list.

13. That the petitioner is trained Teacher and she has required qualification for her selection on the post of trained Teacher but she has not been selected as yet and therefore, in the aforesaid facts and circumstances her name may be included in panel and so she may be appointed as the post of trained teacher.

14. That earlier special leave petition (civil) No. S-22882-22888 of 2004 were filed by several trained teacher for direction upon the state of Bihar to appoint them in the post of primary Teachers in the state of Bihar. The same was withdrawn on an undertaking given on behalf of the state of Bihar on 18.01.2006 whereby the state of Bihar committed itself to recruiting and

filling up the vacant posts of teachers in primary school with trained Teachers.

15. That application made for withdrawal of the special leave petition was disposed of by the Hon'ble court on 23.01.2006 subsequently when the state of Bihar failed to abide by its commitment and assurance the petitioner Nand Kishore Ojha thereafter who filed contempt petition (civil) 207/2006 and the same was disposed of with a direction upon the state of Bihar to implement the undertaking given earlier, upon a categorical statement being made that priority would be given to the trained teachers in matter of appointment in the said posts.

16. That despite several contempt petition,

that order dated 13.01.2011 on the contempt petition filed in S.L.P (C) No-22882 of 2004 arising out of the breach of undertaking given on 19.12.2006, by the state of Bihar and the order passed on the basis thereof on 23.01.2006 in the aforesaid S.L.P., and your lordships were pleased to direct that the trained teachers who at one time were less than number of vacant posts should be given appointment in the vacancies that were available. It is further directed by your Lordships that the said vacancies about 34540 be filled up with the said number of trained teachers.

17. That order dated 18.07.2013 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court whereby it is

directed that some discrepancies had crept in the final select list, the individual grievances contained various anomalies, which it is difficult for ~~us~~ to unravel that order dated 13.10.2011 was modified by your lordship, allow the applicants to approach this Hon'ble High Court or redressed of their grievances. It is also directed that the applications, special leave petitions and writ petitions filed before Hon'ble apex Court has been disposed of with liberty to the parties to approach the Hon'ble Court individually or other~~w~~ise, for relief, if any but without in any way effecting the appointments of those ~~teachers who have already been appointed against the vacant 34540 post and are — against~~ working. It is also directed that

about 2413 posts out of the 34540 posts were still left to be filled up.

18. That in the aforesaid facts and circumstance, interest of justice demands that appointment of petitioner are validly considered filling up the balance vacancies about 2413 posts out of 34540 post which is still left to be filled up.

19. That the petitioner ~~has~~ got no other alternative, efficacious remedy other than to move before this Hon'ble Court for redressed of her grievances.

20. That the petitioner has not filed any application earlier like the present one before this Hon'ble Court or Hon'ble apex Court.

It is therefore prayed that your Lordships may

gloriously be pleased to issue RULE NISI calling upon the respondents with show-cause as to why this writ application be not admitted or disposed of at the time of admission stage itself and after return of RULE and hearing the parties, if no sufficient ground may be shown, make the rule absolute and allow the prayer made in para-1 to the writ application.

It is further prayed that during the pendency of

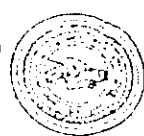
