Most Respectfully Sheweth:-

1. That this application is being filed for initiating a contempt proceeding against the opposite parties for willfully not compliance of the order dated 14.8.2012 passed by the Hon'ble Justice Umesh Kumar Datta in CWJC No. 13514/2012 whereby this Hon'ble Court has directed to the opposite parties concerned to verify the claim of the petitioner and ensure that admissible post retirement dues including different of final pension and provisional pension received by the husband of the petitioner, arrears of family pension and current family pension as also remaining amount of GPF dues with statutory interest till the date of payment within a period of four months from today.

A true photo copy of the
order dated 14.8.12 passed in
CWJC No. 13514/2012 is

being annexed herewith and
marked as Annexure-1 to this
petition.

2. That the petitioner has filed CWJC No. 13514/12 for
following reliefs:-

- (i) For direction to the respondent authorities to make
payment of the dues salary of the husband of the
petitioner since 13.5.1990 to 16.12.1992 with
statutory interest.
- (ii) For further direction to the respondent authorities to
make fixation of the final family pension of the
petitioner whose husband died after retirement on
1.7.2007 till date no final fixation of the family
pension has been made.
- (iii) For further direction to the respondent authorities to
make payment of the difference of amount after

fixation of the final pension of the deceased husband, after deduction of the provisional pension paid to her husband and the petitioner be within time framed with statutory interest.

- (iv) For further direction to the respondent authorities to grant benefits of the A.C.P. Scheme which was due in respect of the husband of the petitioner who died without giving advantage of A.C.P. and further direction to the respondent authorities to make payment of amount of commutation after calculation of the same.
- (v) For further direction to the respondent authorities to make payment of the P.F. amount deposited since in the year 1965 to 1982 which has not been paid to the petitioner with statutory interest with a further direction to the respondent authorities to make finalization of the grievance of the petitioner with

regard to the fixation of final family pension and payment of the retiral dues in respect to the deceased employee Janardan Labh who died on 10.7.2007 and was retired from service with effect from 31.1.2001.

(vi) For any other relief or reliefs for which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper.

3. That the short leading fact of this case is that one Janardan Labh who was the husband of the petitioner was appointed at Jansewak in the year 1963 as on 20.4.1963 and while remaining in service said Janardan Labh was transferred at different places and ultimately the said Janardan Labh was retired from service with effect from 31.1.2001 without any blemish.

4. That it is also submitted that though in the life time of the said employees Janardan Labh he was put under suspension with effect from 13.5.1990, 16.12.1992 due to some

confusion and ultimately the said employee was relieved from her pension without initiating any departmental proceeding.

5. That it is also submitted that petitioner though has tried to obtain the information from the department that whether during the period of suspension said Janardan Labh was paid any subsistence allowance or not but ultimately the petitioner has got knowledge that the said Janardan Labh even was not paid any subsistence allowance during the period of suspension i.e. 13.5.1990 to 16.12.1992.

6. That it is also submitted that ultimately the said Janardan Labh has retired with effect from 31.1.2001 but till the death of the said employee on 1.7.2007 no final fixation of pension of the deceased employee was made due to laches on the part of the opposite parties.

7. That it is submitted that in fact while the said Janardan Labh was alive while making provisional pension a letter was issued by the department concerned with regard to the

deduction of the amount of Rs. 40,000/- one writ application bearing CWJC No. 11873 of 2004 was filed by this deceased employee Janardan Labh against the letter dated 20.1.2004 whereby the amount from the G.P.F. was ordered to be deducted from the Accountant General, Bihar, Patna.

8. That ultimately the said writ application was heard by a bench of this Hon'ble Court and the writ application was allowed directing the opposite parties not to make any deduction from the amount of G.P.F. which is earned of the deceased employee and ultimately the said amount was paid to the deceased employee.

9. That it is submitted that though the some of the amount was paid to the petitioner in view of Annexure-3 of the writ application but till the death of the deceased employee on 10.7.2007 no final fixation of pension was made and ultimately deceased employee died while getting provisional pension and still the petitioner is getting provisional family pension.

10. That it is submitted that petitioner as while was not paid the amount of salary, no final fixation of pension was made to the deceased employee and he died while getting the provisional pension and also the deceased employee was not given the benefit of A.C.P. amount of commutation and amount of Provident Fund the petitioner filed so many representation before the department concerned including the B.D.O. District Magistrate and the Accountant General Bihar, Patna as well as the Chief Secretary raising the grievance that in spite of the death of her husband till date no final fixation nor her husband was paid final fixation rather he has died while giving the provisional pension and as such the petitioner has filed representation before the opposite parties raising grievance and praying therein to make finalization of the grievance of the petitioner as well as the amount be paid it appears that in spite of all these representation the opposite parties has not taken any action till now and as such the amount has not been paid.

11. That it is submitted that it appears from the action of the opposite parties that a letter has been issued by the Senior Accounts Officer, Accountant General of Bihar, Patna that since the deceased employee has not been submitted pension paper the amount has not been finalized and by the letter dated 25.5.2010 the information has been given to the Block Development Officer Murliganj, Madhepura to sent the relevant papers so that the account can be finalized.

12. That it is also submitted that after the letter dated 25.5.2010 the petitioner also filed representation before the Block Development Officer dated 1.7.2010 but in spite of that the opposite parties have not taken any action.

13. That it is also submitted that the petitioner also filed representation before the Accountant General, Bihar, Patna on 2.3.2011 raising all the grievance and has submitted all the relevant facts with regard to the fixation of the family pension and other monetary benefits of retiral dues but it appears that in

spite of the representation the Accountant General Bihar, Patna has also not taken any action nor has passed any positive direction or orders to get settle the entire retiral dues of the petitioner's husband.

14. That it is also submitted that in fact that the petitioner is widow of the deceased employee having no sources of income and is suffering from so many disease of oldness and is not in a position to every day to move to the office of the opposite parties to settlement of the claim and as such the petitioner has also filed application before the Block Development Officer under Right to Information Act with regard to not settlement of the retiral dues but in spite of that neither any information has been given nor the amount of the retiral dues of the deceased employee has been settled.

15. That it is also submitted that the petitioner is also filed application before the Lokayukt, Bihar, Patna against the action of the opposite parties on 30.6.2009 as well as on

26.2.2008 but it appears that all the attempts taken by the petitioner were make futile and till date no positive order has been passed.

16. That it is also submitted that after passing the order dated 14.8.2012 the petitioner filed representation before the opposite parties concerned on 27.5.2012, 29.9.12, 25.9.12 but in spite of the representation till date the payment to the petitioner has not been made.

17. That it is also submitted that from perusal of the order dated 5.12.2012 sent by the Senior Account Officer it appears that a letter was issued to the Block Development

Officer, Murliganj, Madhepura to sent entire record to Nirmala Devi for needful.

A photo copy of Letter dated 5.12.2012 is being annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-3 to this petition.

18. That it is submitted that prior to the letter dated 5.12.2012 a letter was sent by the Block Development Officer, Murliganj informing the details of claim but thereafter a letter was issued on 2.11.2012 by the Senior Account Officer, Bihar Patna but till date no compliance has been made.

A photo copy of Letter No. 11522 dated 2.11.2012 is being annexed herewith and marked as Annexure-4 to this petition.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsels for the State and the Accountant General, Bihar.

The petitioner's grievance is that after the retirement of her husband on 31.1.2001 and till his death on 10.7.2007 he was only being paid provisional pension and even thereafter the family pension has not been paid to the petitioner nor the final pension and difference of provisional pension during the life time of her husband have been given to her.

It is further submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that inadvertently he has deleted the relief for payment of GPF amount for the deposits made in the said account between 1965 to
